TRANSPORT

The nearest airport is Naples International Airport, Aeroporto di Napoli-Capodichino.

From the Airport to our Facility by taxi (30 min trip)

Taxi lane is located in front of Arrivals. We suggest you to agree with the driver for the flat rate (no more than 50€ each way). The flat rate includes any extra charge: to/from airport, night ride, holiday, luggage, animals.

From the Airport to our Facility by car (30 min trip)

Follow Via Ruffo Fulco di Calabria (accessible from the Arrivals terminal). Take A56 (Tangenziale) from Via Ruffo Fulco Di Calabria. Follow A56 (Tangenziale) and take exit 12 (Pozzuoli, Via Campana). After exit, merge onto Via Fascione and take Via Variante Solfatara towards Via Campi Flegrei.

From the Airport to our Facility by public transportation (2 hour trip) ALIBUS service connects the airport to Naples Train Central Station (ticket onboard). From Naples Train Central Station, take the Metro Line 2 (direction Pozzuoli-Solfatara). The entrance of the campus is about 3 km from the Pozzuoli-Solfatara station and can be reached either by taxi or by bus (line M1).
